## TRADITIONAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

1. With few exceptions (such as the Watkins First-Knox, the Utica Class of 1956, and the Harold Smith Utica High School Scholarships) applicants must reside in Knox County or (in some cases) attend a Knox County high school.
2. Applicants must be planning to attend a fully-accredited two-year or four-year college or university, enrolled as a **full-time** student.
3. **Traditional Scholarship Applicants** include graduating high school seniors and students who are continuing undergraduate degree work they began within two years of high school graduation. Traditional Scholarship applicants will be considered for all available Community Foundation scholarships, including the Wilbur Gaunder Engineering Scholarships (college sophomore standing and enrollment in a college of engineering required).

**Non-Traditional Scholarship Applicants** include those competing for a Dr. Lillian Hickman or Dr. Allan Bazzoli Medical School Scholarship, a Dr. Clyde and Dora Purdy O.S.U. Veterinary School Scholarship, or a Robert and Lorene Purdy Scholarship for adults pursuing post-secondary studies for workplace re-entry or retraining, especially in nursing.

4. To be considered for any need-based scholarships applicants must provide the Foundation a **complete copy of the Student Aid Report (SAR)** of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) application (see [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)). Applicants electing to omit the FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR) from this application will be eligible only for merit-based scholarships, which typically are available in lesser numbers, and smaller amounts, compared to need-based scholarships.

**Note: Applicants are permitted to postpone submission of the FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR) until March 15, 2017, if financial information is not available by the March 1, 2017 scholarship application deadline. However, any applicant who does not submit a complete FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR) by the March 15, 2017 deadline will be considered only for merit-based scholarships.**

5. To complete the PDF version of this application on your computer, simply mouse-click in the fields and begin typing your information. You may also tab and shift-tab to move forward and backward through the fields. You will not be able to click or tab into fields that require a signature. **Remember to print application pages immediately if you are only using Adobe Acrobat Reader® as you will not be able to save your work unless your computer has installed a more full-featured version of Adobe Acrobat® or comparable PDF software.**
6. **Important!** Applications from high school seniors, including post-March 1, 2017 submissions of the FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR), **must be submitted to guidance counselors.** Please adhere to all deadlines, as counselors are not permitted to accept late submissions.

Application materials and updates from all other traditional and non-traditional applicants should be mailed directly to the **Community Foundation of Mount Vernon & Knox County, P.O. Box 309, Mount Vernon, OH 43050**, and must be postmarked by the deadline dates to be eligible for consideration.

7. Applicants are responsible for requesting official transcripts **well in advance** of the application deadline. Please exercise courtesy with student records personnel who have several requests made of them at this time of the year. Official transcripts should be submitted directly to the guidance office (for high school seniors) or to the Community Foundation (for all other applicants).
8. **In addition to Sections A, B, C, D and the optional FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR), the following materials must be submitted:**
  - a. Official transcripts from each high school and college attended. (**Please request these ASAP!**)
  - b. A wallet sized, head and shoulder photograph (*not returnable*), suitable for newspaper publication.
